

**SHAMROCK TOWNSHIP
PUBLIC MEETING
Thursday, October 24, 2013**

Board Chairman Charles Quale called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Present were Supervisors Ron Smith and Jerry Pawlak; Clerk Candace Kral; Treasurer John Brula; road maintenance employee Tim Turner, Greg Kimman, Short Elliott Hendrickson Inc. (SEH) Project Engineer and twenty-six (26) residents were present. Sign in sheet attached.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide the property owners/residents with information and to answer questions/concerns for the road improvements to be performed on road sections of Long Point Place, 202nd PL, and 201st Avenue. Greg Kimman, SEH engineer, explained the proposed road improvements to be performed on road sections of Long Point Place, 202nd Place and 201st Avenue. Questions from the residents/property owners were then answered by Greg Kimman regarding concerns that the road lift will not fix the problem of the flooding in the area, that it would worsen the flooding for the resident/property homes and yards. Also concerns for the removal of trees, of how water run-off would affect residents yards and homes were stated; how driveway approaches would be dealt with so as not to cause residents/property owners problems going in and out of their driveways and how the project intends to deal with the properties that have septic tank/drain fields in the road right-of-way. Of the 26 residents/property owners present, 25 were not in favor of the proposed road improvements on Long Point Place/202nd Place.

Following the meeting Greg Kimman and supervisors, met with several residents/property owners at their property to answer individual questions and discuss individual concerns of how the project would affect their property.
