The clerk presented a list of required annual reports that have been submitted to various agencies.

Ron Smith moved to approve the treasurer and clerk's annual reports, seconded by Allen Eld; motion carried.

The board deliberate the condition and replacement for a new utility (pick-up) truck and the condition of the Sterling dump truck. It was also stated that the salt/sand shed needs to be repaired/replaced. It is starting to fall apart. Various road projects for the coming year were examined.

The budget for 2018 was discussed. The board noted the balances of the current levy funds and noted that they have been informed that the fire protection expense will probably be increased by 10% this year and that the Fire Fund needs to be increased to accommodate the expense.

After reviewing the expenses and anticipated projects for 2018, Motion made by Ron Smith, seconded by Allen Eld; to recommend 2018 levies with an increase of \$10,000 to Fire, leaving the other funds the same as last year, recommended levies to be as follows, motion carried.
